How many Mills Brothers were there and can you name them?

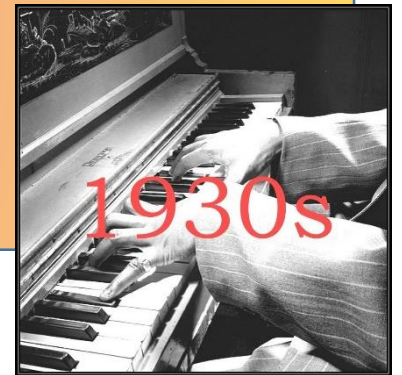
There were **four** Mills Brothers. They were named **John, Herbert, Harry and Donald.**

The Andrew Sisters based themselves on **which** sister-act from the 1930s?

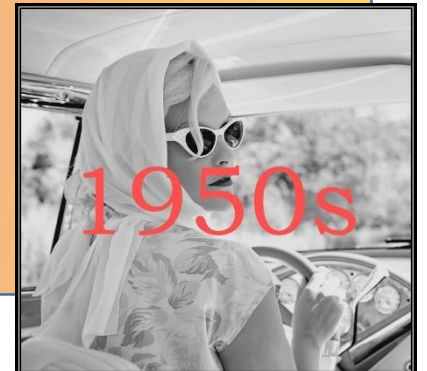
The Boswell Sisters.
